- The newest program of Philmont Scout Ranch, located on the Torstenson Family Wildlife Center in Datil, New Mexico. Approximately 2 hours southwest of Albuquerque.
- Partnership between the Rocky Mountain Elk Foundation and the Boy Scouts of America.
- Camping season arrival dates are June 20th thru July 27th. Crews will arrive on Day 1 and depart for the backcountry on the same day. They will depart by lunch on Day 7.
- Crews will participate in programs such as:
 - o Leave No Trace
 - o Geocaching
 - o GPS navigation skills
 - o Challenge/Team building events
 - o Search and rescue
 - o Map and compass skills
 - o Black powder shooting
 - o Astronomy
 - o Conservation projects
 - o Archery
- One backcountry camp, the Martin Camp. The staff will be providing black powder shooting, archery and a western style dinner. The camp will not be interpretive.
- Located on over 100,000 acres starting at 7,000 feet in elevation to 9,500 feet. Your crew will receive a customized itinerary to meet your goals. You will also enjoy the freedom of being able to hike without trails.
- Wilderness Guide, a Double H staff member, will be with the crew the entire trek. This staff member will provide programs for you while hiking throughout the backcountry.
- The Double H is adaptable to accommodate a crew new to High Adventure or for those that are seasoned backpackers, the choice is yours!
