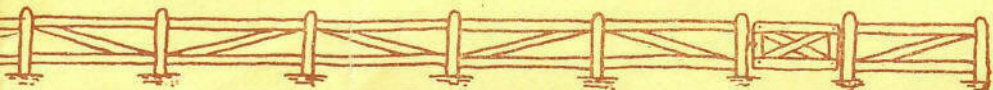


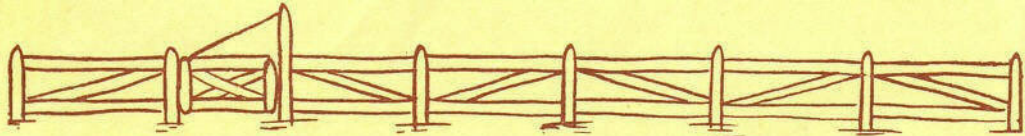

Northbound Expedition - you will:

1st. Day: Arrive Headquarters around 10:00 A. M. Leaders check in with the Chief Clerk and have briefing session with the Program Director. The group will attend to the business of getting physical rechecks, the group picture, shaking down for the trail, storing extra gear and valuables. Late in the afternoon you will be transported to Carson Maxwell Base camp, assigned a campsite and you "are on your way."





- 2nd. Day: Breakfast in the Maxwell dining room. Hike to Olympia for instructions in Basic Scouting skills and in various skills that will fit into your trail program. Lunch and Supper will be served in the Campcraft area. After the evening "Orientation" campfire hike back to Carson Maxwell to spend the night.
- 3rd. Day: Horseback ride to Abreu along the Mesa Trail — Arrive early afternoon for campcraft instructions.
- 4th. Day: At Abreu Base Camp explorations in geology, bird lore, and stream management can be organized. Fly tying and fishing instruction for those interested. Also trailcraft instruction, burro packing, etc.
- 5th. Day: On the trail to Rayado Base Camp. Fishing will be in order for some, others will be interested in the rock formations on the canyon walls. Make camp at Rayado.
- 6th. Day: On trail to Porcupine. Burros and packers hit the trail early. Geologists explore Buck Creek. Naturalists explore Bonito Canyon and hike down Apache to Porcupine.
- 7th. Day: On the trail to Cyphers Mine. Rock and Mineral collectors and those who are working on nature collections stay on the alert on this trail. Make camp at Cyphers Mine.
- 8th. Day: On the trail to Cimarroncito.
- 9th. Day: Moskeet and rifle ranges at Cimarroncito are open daily. Forestry expedition and Conservation projects here. Indian metal work, and stone polishing are the crafts offered here.
- 10th. Day: On the trail to the Bench. Roving archery range on this trail. Look for fossils along the trail. Make camp at the Bench.
- 11th. Day: On the trail to Bent. Stop for lunch at the Bear Canyon fossil study area.
- 12th. Day: At Bent. Last minute work on nature or rock collections. Get trail gear ready for the trip home.
- 13th. Day: To Headquarters to receive your awards and certificates. After lunch — Adios.
